Activities throughout the county



Saturday 19th July: Family Guided Walk. Kilpeck: The life & Death of a Medieval Village. 2.00pm-4.00pm. Why was the castle so important? Why is the church so special? Why and when was the village deserted? Have these questions and many others answered in a short, guided walk around Kilpeck castle, church and village.

Monday 21st July: Clodock: Church, village & mill a guided tour. 2.00pm-4.00pm. A guided tour around the historic village of Clodock concentrating on the church and mill.

Tuesday 22nd July: Historic Landscape Walk. Checkley and environs. 10.00am-1pm. A guided walk around the lanes and fields of Checkley looking at landscape change.

A short, guided walk looking at the castle, medieval village and Offa's Dyke.

A short guided tour of Leintwardine with our resident Roman soldier.
